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




15. TELECONFERENCING

Modify Article 7T of the Teachers' CBA and corresponding provisions of other Agreements as follows: The required participation of special education teachers and/or related service providers in IEPs, EPCs and CSE reviews may be accomplished via teleconferencing at the discretion of the appropriate Principal or Supervisor. If the teleconference occurs during a teacher's preparation period, or during an administrative period in which he or she is relieved, compensation will be paid at the coverage rate. If the teleconference occurs on other than school time, compensation at the applicable per session rate will be paid.

CHAPTER 408 REQUIREMENTS IEPS OF 3K-12TH GRADE MUST COMPLETE THE 408

Regulations of the New York State Commissioner of Education for Chapter 408 require that all those responsible for providing programs, services, and supplementary aid to students with IEPs are familiar with the full scope of each student's current IEP, and their responsibilities for implementing those IEPs.

How do I apply for a restoration of health? via SOLAS

When does our contractual day start and end? depends on each school

If itinerant does supervisor need to keep you in the same district as your payroll school? yes

When should speech only IEPs be held? you choose what time is best for you, can not cancel sessions

Extra 25 minutes in the morning, is it for providers only or also for teachers? Only providers in the pilot workday

For the past 2 years our principal has needed us for arrival duty from 7:40-8:05am which is supposed to be our sesis time. If they request again what should I say? Providers DO NOT do arrival/dismissal duties unless it is a per session assignment you chose to do. Contact your chapter leader and me immediately if you have an assignment during your contractual times.

Right to return to building after a leave? within 2 years you have the right back to your position, within 4 years the right to a position in your district

If we have a student that is mandated to get services in another language and has interim language listed as English, do I list interim language as English on the next IEP, any steps/procedures to be aware of? refer to the SLP Practice guide and speak with your speech supervisor

Do you write a progress report for triennials? Not if you attend. Refer to SOPM page 47

What should we do if told to push into the classroom? If on the IEP it states separate location, you need to follow the legal document. If you are being told to change the IEP that can be brought to the special education compliance committe in your school or file a special education complaint.

I am new to the PRAC team, who is my supervisor or who do I contact for speech related support? Your supervisor is not a speech supervisor. You can contact a colleague or myself. I work with Raul and Naomi to address PRAC issues.
